Health and safety rules for rocket launches

Rockets are super fun – but only when you use them safely.

Here are the top rules to keep yourself and others safe.



Prepare for launch

- 1. An adult has to be with you whenever you use rocket equipment.
- 2. Everyone in your crew must wear eye protection and a high vis vest.
- 3. Check your equipment regularly. Use only new 1.5 litre PET soda bottles. Make sure nothing is loose, damaged, or worn on launcher.
- 4. Set up your launch pad safely on level ground, and point it away from people, animals, buildings, and trees.
- 5. Is it windy or rainy? Hold off until another day.

Launch time

- 1. Always follow launch instructions carefully.
- 2. Create a safety zone for launches. Keep observers at a safe distance and count down to the launch.
- 3. Don't stand over your rocket or get too close when you're about to launch.
- 4. Never push air pressure above 60 psi.
- 5. Wait till your rocket has landed safely before going to retrieve it.
