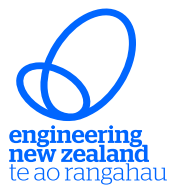




Ākonga reflection template

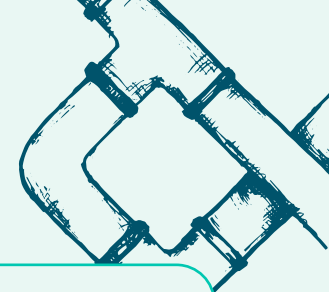
