# The Rocket Challenge

Over 6–8 weeks in Term 3, students work with their teacher and a STEM professional to design, build and launch their very own water rocket. The programme takes just two hours per week and aligns to level 4 of the New Zealand school curriculum.

## What we offer schools

- Online learning hub with modules aligned to level 4 of the New Zealand school curriculum
- Online training for participating teachers on core STEM principles
- Support from a volunteering STEM professional for one hour a week
- Free rocket kit with launcher and safety gear
- Printable activity sheets for students

## Proven impact

Here's what schools had to say about the 2019 Rocket Challenge:

- 91% increased their confidence in teaching STEM
- 90% of teachers and 86% of students said they would do it again

- 86% of students positively changed their perceptions of STEM
